## THREATS TO STUDENTS, EMPLOYEES OR VOLUNTEERS/SPONSORS

## Policy 525

The CISPG Board of Directors recognizes that students, employees, and volunteers/sponsors have the right to a safe and secure school environment.

A threat, either written, verbal, transmitted by electronic media, or any application of force made by student(s) and considered serious by the administration, and which is directed towards students, employees, or volunteers/sponsors, shall be investigated thoroughly and in a timely manner following the BC Safe School Protocols.

## THREATS TO STUDENTS, EMPLOYEES, OR VOLUNTEERS/SPONSORS

Regulations:

In cases where threats of a serious nature, written, verbal, or physical are directed by a student(s) towards another student(s), employee, or volunteer/sponsor the following shall apply:

The Principal or their designate will investigate the matter thoroughly following CISPG Violent Threat/Risk Assessment Procedures, contacting CISPG Safe Schools Coordinators as required. Involvement from other agencies (RCMP, MCFD, Safe Schools BC) may be warranted.

The offending student(s) may be indefinitely suspended during the period of investigation and/or as part of the long-term intervention plan.

Following the investigation, the student may be suspended or expelled as per CISPG policy #506
