



Rationale

Learning requires a safe and healthy environment.

Policy

Schools must provide safe drinking water for staff and students in their schools.

Procedure

Schools will have their water tested annually by October 31st for lead level content by a qualified laboratory as per the EEC Ministry standards and the local Health Authority, and submit their results to CISPG within ten days of receiving their results.

NOTE: The current Canadian guideline for lead in drinking water is a maximum acceptable concentration of 0.005mg/L (5quarts per billion) in drinking water.
