



Rationale

A safe, orderly and caring environment for all students requires clear expectations for behaviour.

Student discipline needs to assist students to take ownership of their behaviour and its consequences.

Policy

Each school shall develop a Code of Conduct that aligns with the CISPG Student Code of Conduct, reflecting Gospel values.

Procedure:

Each school shall develop a student school code conduct that is shared with students, staff and parents on an annual basis. The code of conduct should inculcate:

1. mutual respect among students and staff acknowledging the dignity of each person
2. established standards and expectations to guide a student's conduct in classrooms, other areas of school life, including field trips and school events
3. a commitment from every member of the school staff to support expectations and procedures.
