



THE SUPERINTENDENT DESIGNATE

Rationale

The efficient oversight of the schools requires that in case of a short-term absence of the Superintendent of Schools, a ‘Superintendent Designate’ be appointed.

Policy

The Superintendent Designate must:

1. Be a BC certified teacher.
2. Be an experienced principal (former or current) of CISPG.
3. Have training and experience with “Safe Schools”.
4. Be familiar with the policies of the CISPG Board.

Duties are to:

1. Communicate with schools regarding any emergency situations.
2. Handle all press- related communications.
3. Liaise with Superintendent.

The Superintendent Designate will receive a daily stipend determined by the Superintendent.
