OVERVIEW

CISPG (Catholic Independent Schools, Diocese of Prince George) is a vibrant Catholic organization committed to “ALL learners thriving in innovative, healthy, and inspiring faith communities”. We are looking for a curious, collaborative teacher from each school to join our CISPG Learning Services Team (LST) and support the educators in our schools.

The LST Teacher Lead will report directly to the CISPG Principal of Learning Services. This is a one-year term, with the potential for renewal.



PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Connect, collaborate, and network with other CISPG Teacher Leads, the Christian Education Consultant, and the Principal of Learning on a bi-weekly basis.
- Support the school in the development and implementation of the School Learning Plan (e.g., assist with collection of school data, facilitate school meetings).
- Facilitate/share learning opportunities with educators (e.g., leading school cohort meetings and presenting/sharing at staff meetings regarding current resources and “strong” practice).
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS/SKILLS

- BC teacher certification
- Prefer a minimum of 3 years of successful teaching experience
- Ability to facilitate collaboration among staff members
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Understanding of the BC Curriculum: e.g., Learning Standards, Assessment for Learning (AFL) practice, core competencies
- Understanding of school-based inquiry

The successful candidate will be provided with bi-weekly release time on Thursday afternoons to fulfill the primary responsibilities of the CISPG Teacher Lead. After-school meetings are an integral part of the position. The successful candidate will receive his/her teaching salary plus a stipend of \$2500/year from CISPG.
